



**HIS MAJESTY'S FORCES (MILEAGE-TAX) EMERGENCY
ORDER 1943**

PURSUANT to the Transport Legislation Emergency Regulations 1940,* the Minister of Transport doth hereby order and declare as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as His Majesty's Forces (Mileage-tax) Emergency Order 1943.

2. The provisions of section 4 of the Motor-vehicles Amendment Act, 1934-35, are hereby suspended so far as they relate to the use or operation of any motor-vehicle of which the Crown is the owner or hirer while it is being used exclusively for the purposes of any of His Majesty's Forces.
