## THE HOP MARKETING REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 10

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Marketing Act 1936, and the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Hop Marketing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hop Marketing Regulations 1939\*.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Milage allowance—Regulation 5 of the Hop Marketing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 4, is hereby amended by revoking subclause (3), and substituting the following subclause:
- "(3) The rate of milage allowance referred to in regulation 13 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949† shall be calculated in accordance with the following table:

Horsepower of Car	Milage Allowance
Not exceeding $9\frac{1}{2}$ Exceeding $9\frac{1}{2}$ but not exceeding $14\frac{1}{2}$ Exceeding $14\frac{1}{2}$	4.6c a mile 5.2c a mile 5.8c a mile"
