



**THE HOP MARKETING REGULATIONS 1939,
AMENDMENT NO. 18**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Marketing Act 1936 and the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Hop Marketing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 18, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hop Marketing Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1995.

2. Functions of Board—(1) Regulation 14 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1) the words “and to determine and recommend to the Minister, after consultation with the

New Zealand Brewers' Association, the quantity of bulk hops required to be imported for brewing purposes should the quantity of hops produced in New Zealand be insufficient to meet the requirements of brewers in New Zealand. In the event of disagreement between the Committee and the New Zealand Brewers' Association the matter in dispute shall be decided by the Minister" (as added by regulation 3 of the Hop Marketing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 6).

(2) Regulation 3 of the Hop Marketing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 6, is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 January 1995, take from the New Zealand Hop Marketing Board the function (given to it in 1955) of determining and recommending to the Minister of Agriculture the quantity of bulk hops to be imported when there is a shortfall of locally grown hops.
