## Regulations

#### 1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Heavy Motor Vehicle Amendment Regulations 2004.
- (2) In these regulations, the Heavy Motor Vehicle Regulations 19741 are called "the principal regulations".

#### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 5 April 2004.

## 3 Speed

Regulation 9(10) of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, after the words "section 52 of the Act", the words "before the date of the commencement of section 4 of the Transport Amendment Act 1997 (5 April 2004)".

## **Explanatory note**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 5 April 2004, amend the Heavy Motor Vehicle Regulations 1974. The amendment accommodates the making of the Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2003 (Rule 54001), which also comes into force on 5 April 2004.
