ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 22nd day of November 1965

Pursuant to the Transport Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Heavy Motor Vehicle Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Heavy Motor Vehicle Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) Regulation 6 (1) hereof shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1966.
- (3) Except as provided in subclause (2) of this regulation, these regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1965.
- 2. Regulation 10 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (9), and substituting the following subclause:
- "(9) In respect of any specified heavy motor vehicle that with the load it is carrying weighs 15 tons or over, the appropriate Licensing Authority may issue—
 - "(a) A heavy-traffic licence (as described in subclause (5) of regulation 12 of these regulations and hereinafter referred to as a weekly licence) for a period of seven consecutive days at a fee which is computed at one-eighth of the quarterly fee normally payable for that class and type of vehicle, calculated, where it includes part of a shilling, to the next highest shilling; or

- "(b) A heavy traffic licence (as described in subclause (5) of regulation 12 of these regulations and hereinafter referred to as a two-day licence) for a period of two consecutive days at a fee which is computed at one-twelfth of the quarterly fee normally payable for that class and type of vehicle, calculated, where it includes part of a shilling, to the next highest shilling."
- 3. Regulation 11 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 3 (1) of the Heavy Motor Vehicle Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 6) is hereby further amended—
 - (a) By adding to the heading of the second column of the table of fees in subclause (1) the words "or a Self-propelled Caravan Used Otherwise than for Business Purposes":
 - (b) By adding to the heading of the third column of the same table the words "and for Every Self-propelled Caravan Used Otherwise than for Business Purposes".
 - 4. (1) Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—
 - (a) By inserting in subclause (5), after the words "weekly licence", the words "or two-day licence":
 - (b) By inserting in paragraph (a) of subclause (6), after the words "weekly licence", the words "or two-day licence".
- (2) Regulation 12 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 3 of the Heavy Motor Vehicle Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 1) is hereby further amended by adding to paragraph (b) of subclause (11) the word "or" and by adding to that subclause the following paragraph:
 - "(c) Otherwise than as a self-propelled caravan not used for business purposes when the sole licence carried on the vehicle is for a self-propelled caravan."
- 5. (1) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking form E, and substituting the form E set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- (2) Regulation 6 of the Heavy Motor Vehicle Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 2, is hereby consequentially revoked.
- 6. (1) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking form F, and substituting the form F set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- (2) In the case of a heavy-traffic licence for a self-propelled caravan used otherwise than for business purposes issued during the period commencing on the 1st day of December 1965 and ending with the 31st day of May 1966, the word "(farmer's)" shall be deleted from the front of the form of licence, and the words "(self-propelled caravan)" shall be substituted.



EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 amends regulation 10 (9) of the principal regulations by providing for the issue of two-day licences at one-twelfth of the appropriate quarterly fee for heavy motor vehicles weighing with their loads 15 tons or over. Regulation 3 provides for the application of the farmer's truck rate of fees to heavy-traffic licences issued for self-propelled caravans used otherwise than

for business purposes.

Regulations 4 to 6 are consequential on the provisions relating to self-propelled caravans.
