HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Health Act, 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Health (Registration of Premises) Amendment Regulations 1948.
- 2. These regulations shall be read with and form part of the regulations relating to the registration of premises by local authorities made under the Health Act, 1920, on the 10th day of May, 1921, and published in the *Gazette* on the 19th day of the same month at page 1187 (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. The principal regulations may hereafter be cited as the Health (Registration of Premises) Regulations 1921.
- 4. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by prefixing thereto the following words: "Subject to such provisions relating to continuance in force of registration and to the time of renewal of registration and the period for which renewal is effective as may be contained in the by-laws of the local authority from time to time in force."
