THE HIRE PURCHASE AND CREDIT SALES STABILISATION REGULATIONS 1957, AMENDMENT NO. 14

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 19th day of July 1967

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Hire Purchase and Credit Sales Stabilisation Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 14, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hire Purchase and Credit Sales Stabilisation Regulations 1957* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Subclause (2) of regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

“(c) Made by a religious body within the meaning of the Marriage Act 1955 for the purpose of enabling a person whose name is for the time being entered on the list of officiating ministers compiled under that Act to purchase a motorcar for use in his official duties performed on behalf of that religious body.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations exclude the provisions of regulation 6 of the principal regulations so as to permit the making of a loan by a religious body to one of its officiating ministers for the purpose of purchasing a motorcar for use in official duties.
