**THE HIRE PURCHASE AND CREDIT SALES STABILISATION
REGULATIONS 1957, AMENDMENT NO. 19**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 30th day of June 1969

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Hire Purchase and Credit Sales Stabilisation Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 19, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hire Purchase and Credit Sales Stabilisation Regulations 1957* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Subclause (1) of regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in the definition of the term "consumer goods" (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Hire Purchase and Credit Sales Stabilisation Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 4), before the word "animals", the word "buses".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide for buses to be excluded from the term "consumer goods".
