Hides Emergency Regulations 1940 (No. 2)

NOTICE FIXING SCALES OF STANDARD DOMESTIC VALUES AND FLOOR PRICES

Pursuant to the Hides Emergency Regulations 1940 (No. 2)* (in this notice referred to as the regulations) the Minister of Marketing, after consultation with the Hides Committee and with the concurrence of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby give notice as follows:—

- 1. This notice may be cited as the Hides Prices Notice 1949.
- 2. This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1949.
- 3. The Scale of Domestic Values prescribed under Regulation 6 of the regulations and set out in the Schedule thereto and the Scale of Floor Prices prescribed under Regulation 19B of the regulations (as enacted by Regulation 6 of the Hides Emergency Regulations 1940 (No. 2), Amendment No. 1†) and set out in the Second Schedule to the regulations are hereby revoked, and the following new scales substituted:—
