THE HIDES PRICES NOTICE 1950

Hides Regulations 1950

PURSUANT to the Hides Regulations 1950* (in this notice referred to as the regulations) the Minister of Marketing, after consultation with the Hides Committee and with the concurrence of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby give notice as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Hides Prices Notice 1950.
2. This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1951.
3. The Scale of Standard Domestic Values prescribed under regulation 6 of the regulations and set out in the First Schedule thereto is hereby revoked, and the following new scale substituted:—
