#### Hides Regulations 1950

Pursuant to the Hides Regulations 1950\* (in this notice referred to as the regulations) the Minister of Marketing, after consultation with the Hides Committee and with the concurrence of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby gives notice as follows:-

- 1. This notice may be cited as the Hides Prices Notice 1952.
- 2. This notice shall come into force on the 17th day of November 1952.
- 3. (1) The scale of Standard Domestic Values prescribed under regulation 6 of the regulations and set out in the First Schedule thereto (as amended by the Hides Prices Notice 1950† and the Hides Prices Notice 1950, Amendment No. 1) is hereby revoked, and the following new scale substituted:-
