PURSUANT to section 62 of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Horticultural Prescribed Products (Export Licence Fee) Regulations 1987.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Export licence application fee—The fee payable in respect of any application under section 35 of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987 for an export licence shall be \$400 for each prescribed product for which a licence is sought.
