ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 31 of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture and the Minister of Overseas Trade and Marketing made in compliance with section 32 of that Act, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Horticultural Prescribed Products (Plums) Order 1987, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Horticultural Prescribed Products (Plums) Order 1987* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Recognised product group—Clause 5 of the principal order is hereby amended by omitting the words “The Summerfruit Export

Council”, and substituting the words “The New Zealand Summerfruit Export Council Limited”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order effects a technical amendment reflecting the fact that the Summerfruit Export Council, which is the recognised product group for plums for the purposes of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987, has been incorporated and has changed its name to the New Zealand Summerfruit Export Council Limited.
