HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 31 (2) of the New Zealand Horticultural Export Authority Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—This order may be cited as the Horticultural Prescribed Products (Persimmons) Order 1988, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Horticultural Prescribed Products (Persimmons) Order 1988* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Recognised product group—Regulation 5 of the principal order is hereby amended by omitting the words "Persimmons Association of New Zealand Inc.", and substituting the words "body on the commencement of

the Horticultural Prescribed Products (Persimmons) Order 1988, Amendment No. 1 known as the Persimmon Export Council Limited”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force 28 days after notification in the *Gazette*, amends the Horticultural Prescribed Products (Persimmons) Order 1988 so as to take account of the change of the name of the Persimmons Association of New Zealand Inc. to the Persimmon Export Council Limited.
