ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE RIGHT HON. G. W. R. PALMER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 24 of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture and the Minister of Overseas Trade and Marketing made in compliance with section 25 of that Act, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Horticultural Prescribed Products (Blueberries) Order 1989.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1989.

- 2. Interpretation—In this order,—
 - "The Act" means the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987:

"Blueberries" means the product specified in clause 3 of this order.

3. Blueberries declared to be a prescribed product—The following product is hereby declared to be a prescribed product for the purposes of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987:

Blueberries (Vaccinium corymbosum and Vaccinium ashei).

4. Blueberries to be subject to export licensing—Blueberries are hereby declared to be subject to export licensing in accordance with Part III of the Act.

5. Recognised product group—The New Zealand Blueberry Export Council is hereby declared to be the product group recognised under section 25 of the Act as suitable to carry out the functions of a recognised product group in relation to blueberries.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 July 1989, declares blueberries to be a prescribed product for the purposes of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987. They are to be subject to export licensing in accordance with Part III of that Act, and the New Zealand Blueberry Export Council is declared to be the relevant recognised product group.

Blueberries were formerly subject to the Berryfruit Marketing Licensing Regulations 1983, but are now excluded from the ambit of those regulations by the Berryfruit Marketing Licensing Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 3.
