THE HEALTH (IMPORTATION) REGULATIONS, 1936.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Health Act, 1920.

Date on which the regulations were made: 11th day of November, 1936.

Date of notification in Gazette: 19th day of November, 1936.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Health (Importation) Regulations, 1936.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made on the 27th day of April, 1923,* relating to the importation of certain articles (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of December, 1936.

4. The principal regulations are amended by adding to Regulation 3 thereof the following additional clause :—

"(d) Any used or second-hand sacks:

"Provided that this clause shall not be deemed to prohibit the importation of sacks in which any articles are being imported if such sacks have not been used for any purpose on any previous occasion."
