ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 16th day of June 1954

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilization Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hides Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hides Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definitions of the terms "Department" and "Minister", and substituting the following definitions:

"Department" means the Department of Agriculture:

"Minister" means the Minister of Agriculture; and includes any other Minister of the Crown acting for the purposes of these regulations with the authority or concurrence of the Minister of Agriculture:".

(2) Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows:

(a) By revoking paragraph (a) of subclause (1):

(b) By omitting from subclause (3) the words "the Director of Marketing or".

3. (1) Regulation 15 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (4) the words "to the credit of the Meat Industry Account", and substituting the words "into the Public Account".

(2) Regulation 15 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking subclause (5), and substituting the following subclause:

“(5) Where at any time the money for the time being in the Equalization Fund is insufficient to meet the expenditure payable out of the Fund under these regulations, there shall from time to time be paid into the Fund out of money appropriated by Parliament such sum or sums as shall be required to meet that expenditure.”

(3) Regulation 23 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “to the credit of the Meat Industry Account”, and substituting the words “into the Public Account”.

4. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 16.

(2) Regulation 14 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) Money payable into the Fund pursuant to subclause (5) of regulation 15 of these regulations; and”.

(3) Regulation 17 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a) of subclause (4).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*]

Regulation 2 amends the principal regulations consequentially on the provisions of the Marketing Amendment Act 1953, which confers on the Minister of Agriculture all the functions of the Minister of Marketing and on the Department of Agriculture all the functions of the Marketing Department.

The effect of regulation 3 is that any deficiency in the Hides Equalization Fund will in future be met from the Consolidated Fund instead of from the Meat Industry Account.

Regulation 4 abolishes the power given to the Hides Committee by regulation 16 of the principal regulations to impose a levy on exported hides.
