

THE HEALTH (BURSARIES) REGULATIONS 1965, AMENDMENT NO. 2

Pursuant to the Health Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Health (Bursaries) Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Health (Bursaries) Regulations 1965* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date

of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Nursing bursaries—(1) Regulation 3 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Health (Bursaries) Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by adding the following

paragraph:

"(f) Nursing bursaries, being bursaries awarded to assist persons to undertake or complete, in an approved school of nursing controlled or maintained by the Department of Education, nursing programmes prescribed or comprised in a scheme approved and adopted under the Nurses Act 1971 and thereby to qualify for registration under that Act."

(2) Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in paragraph (a) of subclause (1), after the words "approved

training school", the words "or approved school of nursing".

(3) Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in paragraph (f), after the words "approved training school", the words "or approved school of nursing".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations extend the Health (Bursaries) Regulations 1965 so that they will now apply to nursing bursaries.
