REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Hairdressers (Health) Regulations Extension Order 1941, No. 2.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Hairdressers (Health) Regulations 1931* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. The principal regulations shall be in force in the town district set out in the Schedule hereto on and from the 1st day of October, 1941.
