## **THE HOSIERY RATIONING ORDER 1942**

PURSUANT to Regulation 8 of the Rationing Emergency Regulations 1942\* (hereinafter referred to as the regulations), the Minister of Supply and Munitions doth hereby make the following Order :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Hosiery Rationing Order 1942.

2. This Order shall come into force on the 27th day of April, 1942.

3. The following goods shall be rationed goods for the purposes of the regulations—namely, women's full-length hosiery of silk, art. silk, lisle, or any mixture thereof.
