



**THE HOSPITAL REPRESENTATION ORDER 1944**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 21st day  
of April, 1944

Present:

THE HON. D. G. SULLIVAN PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Hospital Representation Order 1944.

2. The Order in Council made on the 25th day of March, 1935,\* making provision for the apportionment of representation of contributory districts on Hospital Boards, as amended by Order in Council made on the 3rd day of November, 1937†, and the Hospital Representation Order 1941‡, is hereby further amended by revoking the Second Schedule thereto so far only as it affects—

(a) The representation in the Whangaroa and Hokianga Hospital Districts; and

(b) The representation upon the Boards of the hospital districts named in the first column of the Schedule hereto of the contributory districts named in the second column of the said Schedule.

3. The numbers of members to be elected to the respective Boards of the hospital districts named in the first column of the Schedule hereto as the representative or representatives of the contributory districts (including combined districts) named in the second column thereof shall be the numbers specified in the third column thereof respectively.

4. The respective contributory districts the names of which are set out in the second column of the Schedule hereto and therein bracketed together are combined into combined districts.

5. The respective contributory local authorities, the districts of which are distinguished in the second column of the Schedule hereto by the letter “(P),” are selected to be the principal contributory local authorities of the combined districts in which the districts of such contributory local authorities are included.

6. The following provision is made for particular cases:—
- (a) The date of the first election of an additional representative for the New Plymouth Borough, Wanganui City, Palmerston North City, Greymouth Borough, and Timaru Borough shall be the date of the next ordinary general election of members of Borough Councils:
- (b) The first election of representatives for each of the combined districts hereby created the principal contributory local authority of which is a County Council shall take place on the date of the next ordinary general election of County Councils, and in the meantime the representatives of the districts and combined districts heretofore existing shall continue to hold office until the date of the next ordinary general election of County Councils:
- (c) The first election of representatives for the Invercragill City and representatives for the respective combined districts of the Marton Borough and Taihape Borough, and Bluff Borough, Winton Borough, South Invercragill Borough, and Stewart Island County shall take place on the date of the next ordinary general election of members of Borough Councils, and in the meantime the representatives of the combined districts heretofore existing shall continue to hold office until the date of the next ordinary general election of Borough Councils.
