**THE HOSPITAL REPRESENTATION ORDER 1950**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 18th day of  
October, 1950

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Hospital Representation Order 1950.

2. The Second Schedule to the Order in Council made on the 25th day of March, 1935,\* the Schedule to the Order in Council made on the 12th day of April, 1938†, and the Schedule to the Hospital Representation Order 1944‡, are hereby amended by revoking so much thereof as affects the representation upon the Boards of the hospital districts named in the first column of the Schedule hereto of the contributory districts named in the second column of the said Schedule.

3. The numbers of members to be elected to the respective Boards of the hospital districts named in the first column of the Schedule hereto as the representative or representatives of the contributory districts (including combined districts) named in the second column thereof shall be the numbers specified in the third column thereof respectively.

4. The respective contributory districts the names of which are set out in the second column of the Schedule hereto and therein bracketed together are hereby combined into combined districts.

5. The respective contributory local authorities the districts of which are distinguished in the second column of the Schedule hereto by the letter “ (P) ” are hereby selected to be the principal contributory local authorities of the combined districts in which the districts of those contributory local authorities are included.

6. The following provision is hereby made for particular cases :—

- (a) The date of the first election of an additional representative for Hamilton City and Alexandra Borough shall be Saturday, the 18th day of November, 1950.
- (b) The first election of representatives for each of the combined districts created by this Order shall take place on Saturday, the 18th day of November, 1950, and until that election the representatives of the combined districts heretofore existing shall continue to hold office.

(c) The present representatives of the Waihi Borough, and of the Westland and Vincent Counties shall continue to hold office until Saturday, the 18th day of November, 1950.

7. The Northland Hospital District Order 1950\* is hereby amended by omitting from clause 7 the word "Health", and substituting the word "Hospital".
