THE HOSPITAL REPRESENTATION ORDER 1953

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Hospital Representation Order 1953.

2. The Second Schedule to the Order in Council made on the 25th day of March 1935* making provision for the apportionment of representation of contributory districts on Hospital Boards, the Schedule to the Order in Council made on the 22nd day of September 1937[†], making similar provision, the Schedule to the Hospital Representation Order 1944[‡], the Schedule to the Hospital Representation Order 1947[§], and the Schedule to the Hospital Representation Order 1950||, are hereby amended by revoking so much thereof as affects the representation upon the Boards of the hospital districts named in the first column of the Schedule hereto of the contributory districts named in the second column of the said Schedule.

3. The numbers of members to be elected to the Boards of the hospital districts named in the first column of the Schedule hereto as the representative or representatives of the contributory districts (including combined districts) named in the second column thereof shall be the numbers specified in the third column thereof.

4. The contributory districts of which the names are set out in the second column of the Schedule hereto and therein bracketed together are hereby combined into combined districts.

5. The contributory local authorities whose districts are distinguished in the second column of the Schedule hereto by the letter "(P)" are hereby selected to be the principal contributory local authorities of the combined districts in which the districts of those contributory local authorities are included.

6. The following provision is hereby made for particular cases:

- (a) The date of the first election of an additional representative for Palmerston North City, and for the Patea, Blenheim, and Westport Boroughs, and for Thames County, and for the combined district of Lower Hutt City and the Eastbourne Borough, shall be Saturday, the 31st day of October 1953.
- (b) The first election of representatives for each of the combined districts created by this Order shall take place on Saturday, the 31st day of October 1953, and until that election the representatives of the combined districts heretofore existing shall continue to hold office.
- (c) The present representatives of Wellington City and of the Patea, Kairanga, Marlborough, and Buller Counties shall continue to hold office until Saturday, the 31st day of October 1953.
- (d) The date of the first election of representatives for the Levin and Upper Hutt Boroughs and the Hawke's Bay and Hutt Counties shall be Saturday, the 31st day of October 1953.
