- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Health Reforms (Transferee) Order 1999.
 - (2) This order comes into force on 12 November 1999.
- 2. Transferee—(1) Ngati Porou Hauora Incorporated is a transferee for the purposes of the Health Reforms (Transitional Provisions) Act 1993.

(2) Ngati Porou Hauora Incorporated is a society incorporated under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 12 November 1999, declares Ngati Porou Hauora Incorporated to be a transferee for the purposes of the Health Reforms (Transitional Provisions) Act 1993.
