**THE HOSPITAL REPRESENTATION ORDER (NO. 2) 1956**

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

1. This order may be cited as the Hospital Representation Order (No. 2) 1956.

2. The Second Schedule to the Order in Council made on the 25th day of March 1935,\* making provision for the apportionment of representation of contributory districts on Hospital Boards, as amended by the Hospital Representation Order 1947†, is hereby further amended by revoking so much of the second and third columns of the Schedule thereto as relates to the combined district of Takaka County, Collingwood County, and Takaka Town District within the Nelson Hospital District, and to the number of representatives of that combined district on the Board of that Hospital District, and substituting the following words:

“Golden Bay County ..... 1”.

3. (1) The date of the first election of a representative for the Golden Bay County shall be Saturday the 17th day of November 1956.

(2) The present representative of the combined district of Takaka County, Collingwood County, and Takaka Town District shall continue to hold office until the representative of the Golden Bay County elected at such first election as aforesaid comes into office.
