PURSUANT to section 2 (1) of the Health Reforms (Transitional Provisions) Act 1993, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Health Reforms (Transferees) Order (No. 2) 1993.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 29th day of June 1993.

2. Transferees—(1) Each of the companies named in the Schedule to this order is hereby declared to be a transferee for the purposes of the Health Reforms (Transitional Provisions) Act 1993.

(2) Each of the companies named in the Schedule to this order is a company incorporated under the Companies Act 1955.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 29 June 1993, declares 2 companies, namely,—

- (a) Health Benefits Limited; and
- (b) Pharmaceutical Management Agency Limited,—

to be transferees for the purposes of the Health Reforms (Transitional Provisions) Act 1993.

Each of those companies is, in its capacity as a transferee within the meaning of that Act,—

- (a) A company to which assets or liabilities or both may be transferred under section 4 or section 5 of that Act; and
- (b) A company that may be authorised to act on behalf of one or more transferors in providing goods or services or in managing assets or liabilities or both.
