PURSUANT to section 13 (1) (a) of the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Higher Salaries Commission (Jurisdiction) Order 1985.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. New Zealand Wheat Board—Part II of the First Schedule to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977 (as substituted by section 3 of the Higher Salaries Commission Amendment Act 1980) is hereby amended by omitting the following item:

“The New Zealand Wheat Board.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but it is intended to indicate its general effect.

Under section 12 (1) (a) (ii) of the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977 the Higher Salaries Commission has jurisdiction to consider and determine the salary of the highest paid executive officer of each of the corporations specified in the First Schedule to that Act and the salaries of such other officers of those corporations as the Commission thinks fit.

This order omits from Part II of that Schedule the name of the New Zealand Wheat Board.
