

THE HIGHER SALARIES COMMISSION (JURISDICTION) ORDER 1987

ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 13 (1) of the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Higher Salaries Commission (Jurisdiction) Order 1987.

(2) Except as provided in clause 2 (4) of this order, this order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Statutory officers appointed under Labour Relations Act 1987 whose salaries are to be determined by the Higher Salaries Commission—(1) The Fourth Schedule to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977 (as substituted by section 3 of the Higher Salaries Commission Amendment Act 1980) is hereby amended by revoking the item relating to the nominated members of the Arbitration Court, and substituting the following item:

"The Chief Commissioner and other Commissioners of the Arbitration Commission (being the members of that Commission appointed under section 261 (1) (a) of the Labour Relations Act 1987)."

(2) The said Fourth Schedule (as amended by section 8 of the Higher Salaries Commission Amendment Act (No. 2) 1985) is hereby further amended by revoking the item relating to conciliators appointed under section 63 of the Industrial Relations Act 1973 and the item relating to mediators appointed under section 64 of that Act.

(3) The said Fourth Schedule is hereby further amended by inserting, before the item relating to the Ombudsmen, the following item:

"The Chief Mediator and other Mediators appointed under section 251 of the Labour Relations Act 1987."

(4) This clause shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1987.

3. Other statutory officers whose salaries are to be determined by the Higher Salaries Commission—(1) The Fourth Schedule to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977 (as substituted by section 3 of the Higher Salaries Commission Amendment Act 1980) is hereby amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Ombudsmen, the following item: "The Barliamentary Commission of the Fourier and the Fourier and the Salaries are the following item:

"The Parliamentary Commissioner for the Environment."

(2) The said Fourth Schedule is hereby further amended by adding, after the item relating to the State Services Commission, the following item:

"The Principal Tenancy Adjudicator and the Deputy Principal Tenancy Adjudicator."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The order amends the Fourth Schedule to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977 (which lists statutory officers whose salaries and principal allowances are determined by the Higher Salaries Commission).

Clause 2, which comes into force on 1 August 1987, effects amendments to that Schedule that are consequential on the coming into force on that date of the Labour Relations Act 1987.

Clause 3, which comes into force on the day after the date of the notification of the order in the Gazette, includes in that Schedule references to—

(a) The Parliamentary Commissioner for the Environment; and

(b) The Principal Tenancy Adjudicator and Deputy Principal Tenancy Adjudicator.

Jurisdiction in respect of those officers was conferred on the Higher Salaries Commission by section 9(1) of the Environment Act 1986 and by section 69(1) of the Residential Tenancies Act 1986.
