ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 4th day of December 1978

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 13 (1) of the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Higher Salaries Commission (Jurisdiction) Order (No. 3) 1978.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Statutory officers whose salaries are to be determined by the Higher Salaries Commission—(1) The Fourth Schedule to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977 is hereby amended by inserting, after the item relating to the members of the Accident Compensation Commission, the following item:

“The nominated members of the Arbitration Court.”

(2) The said Fourth Schedule is hereby further amended by inserting, after the item relating to the Human Rights Commissioners, the following item:

“The members of the Industries Development Commission.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order gives the Higher Salaries Commission jurisdiction to consider and determine the salaries of—

- (a) The nominated members of the Arbitration Court; and
- (b) The members of the Industries Development Commission.
