ORDER 1977**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 1st day of August 1977

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 52 (13) of the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Hospitals (Electronic Technicians) Exemption Order 1977.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 28th day of May 1972.

2. Exemption—Except to the extent specified in section 52 (12) of the Hospitals Act 1957, hospital employees in the occupational class of electronic technicians are hereby exempted from the application of the Industrial Relations Act 1973.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order exempts electronic technicians employed by hospital boards from the application of the Industrial Relations Act 1973 as from 28 May 1972, the date on which a determination relating to their remuneration and conditions of employment was made under the State Services Remuneration and Conditions of Employment Act 1969.
