THE HON. J. R. MARSHALL PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Milk Act 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

—
O R D E R

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Hutt Valley and Bays Metropolitan Milk Board Order 1963.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) The Hutt Valley and Bays Metropolitan Milk Board (as re-constituted by the Hutt Valley and Bays Metropolitan Milk Board Order 1958*) shall hereafter, subject to the provisions of section 20 of the Milk Act 1944 and of this order, consist of seven representatives of the constituent districts within the Hutt Valley and Bays Metropolitan Milk District, as constituted by the Hutt Valley and Bays Metropolitan Milk District Order 1963†.

(2) The Board shall continue to be the Milk Authority of the said district.

3. The constituent districts, the names of which are set out in the first column of the Schedule hereto and therein bracketed together, are hereby combined into combined districts.

4. The number of representatives of each constituent district or combined district within the said milk district on the Board shall be the number specified in the Schedule hereto opposite the name of the constituent district or the group of names of constituent districts comprising a combined district.

5. The first election of the representative of the combined district comprising the Boroughs of Tawa and Porirua shall be held on the 27th day of February 1963, and the representative of the combined district heretofore existing, comprising the Borough of Tawa Flat, the Porirua Riding of the Makara County and such portion of the Makara Riding of that county as is included in the milk district, shall continue in office until that date and shall then retire.

6. The Hutt Valley and Bays Metropolitan Milk Board Order 1958 is hereby revoked.

This order reconstitutes the Hutt Valley and Bays Metropolitan Milk Board consequent on the abolition of the County of Makara and the constitution of part of the abolished county as the Borough of Porirua.
