PURSUANT to section 38 of the Immigration Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Arrival and Departure) Regulations 1981.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 31st day of May 1981.

2. Interpretation—In these regulations "the Act" means the Immigration Act 1964.

3. Forms of declarations—(1) Every declaration required by section 33 (1) of the Act to be made by a person on entering New Zealand shall be made in form 1 or form 2 in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Every declaration required by section 33 (1) of the Act to be made by a person on leaving New Zealand shall be made in form 3 in the Schedule to these regulations.

4. Revocations—(1) Form 14 in the Schedule to the Immigration Restriction Regulations 1930 (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Immigration Restriction Regulations 1930, Amendment No. 6) is hereby revoked.

(2) The Immigration Restriction Regulations 1930, Amendment No. 6* are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe the forms of declarations required by section 33 of the Immigration Act 1964 to be made by persons entering or leaving New Zealand.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936. Date of notification in *Gazette:* 14 May 1981. These regulations are administered in the Department of Labour.
