



**THE IMMIGRATION (ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE)  
REGULATIONS 1981**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 11th day of May 1981

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. R. D. MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 38 of the Immigration Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

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**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Arrival and Departure) Regulations 1981.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 31st day of May 1981.

**2. Interpretation**—In these regulations “the Act” means the Immigration Act 1964.

**3. Forms of declarations**—(1) Every declaration required by section 33 (1) of the Act to be made by a person on entering New Zealand shall be made in form 1 or form 2 in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Every declaration required by section 33 (1) of the Act to be made by a person on leaving New Zealand shall be made in form 3 in the Schedule to these regulations.

**4. Revocations**—(1) Form 14 in the Schedule to the Immigration Restriction Regulations 1930 (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Immigration Restriction Regulations 1930, Amendment No. 6) is hereby revoked.

(2) The Immigration Restriction Regulations 1930, Amendment No. 6\* are hereby revoked.
