THE INDUSTRIAL AND PROVIDENT SOCIETIES FEES REGULATIONS 1939.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

By his Deputy, MICHAEL MYERS.

Pursuant to the Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Industrial and Provident Societies Fees Regulations 1939.
- 2. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of September, 1939.
- 3. The regulations made on the 19th day of December, 1881,* and the 9th day of June, 1891,† under the Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1877, and enuring under the Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1908 (hereinafter called the said Act), are revoked.
- 4. There shall be paid to every Registrar of Industrial and Provident Societies the fees set out in the First Schedule hereto for and in respect of the several matters and things therein set forth.
 - **5.** The said fees shall be payable as follows:—
 - (i) For a document to be received or to be received and registered by the Registrar, upon presentation thereof.
 - (ii) For a document to be issued by the Registrar, before issue
 - (iii) For a reference or an application to the Registrar, upon making the reference or application.
 - (iv) For inspection of a document, before inspection is afforded.
 - (v) For a copy or a certified copy of or extract from a document, upon making request for the same.
- 6. There shall be paid to every Revising Barrister under the said Act the fees set out in the Second Schedule hereto for and in respect of the several matters and things therein set forth, and such fees shall be payable to the Revising Barrister upon presentation to him of the document in respect of which his certificate is required.
- 7. If any question arises as to the fee payable to a Revising Barrister the decision of the Registrar thereon shall be final.
