PURSUANT to the Industrial and Provident Societies Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Industrial and Provident Societies Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Industrial and Provident Societies Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1968.

2. New scale of fees prescribed—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First and Second Schedules, and substituting the First and Second Schedules set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe new scales of fees payable to the Registrar of Industrial and Provident Societies and to revising barristers appointed for the purposes of the Industrial and Provident Societies Act 1908. All but one of the fees listed in the new scales have been increased but a number of fees, including search fees, which are provided for in the existing scales have been abolished. The new scales come into force on 1 January 1968.
