ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of December 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Industrial and Provident Societies Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Industrial and Provident Societies Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Industrial and Provident Societies Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Form of declaration of non-disclosure—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 5A (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Industrial and Provident Societies Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1), the following heading and regulation:

“FORM OF DECLARATION OF NON-DISCLOSURE

“5B. Every declaration made under section 13A (2) of the Industrial and Provident Societies Act 1908 shall be in the form set out in the Fourth Schedule to these regulations.”

(2) The principal regulations are hereby amended by adding, after the Third Schedule, the Fourth Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

DECLARATION OF NON-DISCLOSURE UNDER SECTION 13A (2) OF THE
INDUSTRIAL AND PROVIDENT SOCIETIES ACT 1908
