PURSUANT to the Industrial and Provident Societies Act 1908, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Industrial and Provident Societies Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Industrial and Provident Societies Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1996.
- 2. Revocations—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 3 and the First Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3

(2) Regulation 3 of, and the Schedule to, the Industrial and Provident Societies Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 3 is hereby consequentially revoked.
