### Regulations

- Title**  
These regulations are the Insolvency Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2001.
- Commencement**  
These regulations come into force on 29 June 2001.

### 3 Commencement of Insolvency Amendment Regulations 2001

Regulation 2 of the Insolvency Amendment Regulations 2001 is amended by omitting the expression “1 July”, and substituting the expression “1 October”.

#### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 29 July 2001, defer the commencement of the Insolvency Amendment Regulations 2001 from 1 July 2001 until 1 October 2001. The effect of the deferral is that, until 1 October 2001, the filing fee payable for a creditor’s petition will continue to be \$200, and the filing fee payable for a request for a bankruptcy notice will continue to be \$165.
