PURSUANT to sections 6 and 7 of the Import Control Act 1988, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Import Control Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Import Control Regulations 1988* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) Subject to subclause (3) of this regulation, these regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1989.

(3) Subclause (5) of regulation 3 of these regulations, and the Fifth Schedule to these regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1989.

2. Interpretation—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from the definition of the term "Tariff item" the words "Customs Act 1966", and substituting the words "Tariff Act 1988":
- (b) By omitting from the definition of the term "Minister" the words "Trade and Industry", and substituting the word "Commerce".

3. Amendments to principal regulations—(1) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the Tariff items and descriptions of classes of goods specified in the First Schedule to these regulations.

(2) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by inserting, in their appropriate order, the Tariff items and descriptions of classes of goods specified in the Second Schedule to these regulations.

(3) The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the classes of goods specified in the Third Schedule to these regulations.

(4) The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by inserting, in their appropriate order, the classes of goods specified in the Fourth Schedule to these regulations.

(5) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting the Tariff items and descriptions of classes of goods specified in the Fifth Schedule to these regulations.

- (b) Household or other effects, subject to such conditions as the Minister may prescribe, which are imported by a person who satisfies the Collector that the importer intends henceforth to reside permanently in New Zealand, that the importer has resided or been domiciled outside New Zealand for the whole of the period of 21 months preceding arrival in New Zealand, and that the effects have been personally owned and used by the importer outside New Zealand before the date of his departure for New Zealand:

Provided that if the wearing apparel, other personal effects, or household or other effects are not imported within 5 years after the date of arrival in New Zealand of the person by whom they have been owned and used, they shall be admitted under this item only with the consent of the Minister.

A motor vehicle, which is the personal property of the importer, and has been owned and used by the importer for a period of 90 days and registered in the name of the importer overseas prior to delivery for export to New Zealand.

Provided that-

- (a) Only one vehicle per importer may be imported under this exemption in any 12 month period; and
- (b) For the purposes of this exemption the expression "used" means driven by the importer, on public roads, other than for the purpose of, or for purposes incidental to, testing or registering the vehicle, or delivering for export to New Zealand.

Motor vehicles which are not intended for any other person or persons or for gift, sale, or exchange and are imported by a person who satisfies the Collector—

(a) That the person intends henceforth to reside permanently in New Zealand; and

- (c) That, in respect of every such vehicle, the importer has personally owned and used the vehicle for at least 1 year before the date of the importer's departure for New Zealand or the date of shipment of the vehicle, whichever is the earlier.
- Goods (other than motor vehicles) which are imported as accompanied baggage by a passenger arriving in New Zealand, and—
 - (a) Are carried in the same vessel or aircraft as the passenger; and
 - (b) Are for the passenger's own personal use or as bona fide personal gifts; and
 - (c) Are not for the purposes of sale, business, or for use in the trade, calling or profession of the passenger; and
 - (d) Are not imported on behalf of any other person or persons.

Goods (other than motor vehicles) which qualify for admission under the duty concession for crew members' baggage and effects admitted under Part II of the Customs Tariff.

The following goods designed or produced exclusively for religious purposes, viz:

- (a) Braids and trimmings incorporating religious motifs; and
- (b) Communion "glasses" and plates of plastic; and
- (c) Crucifix corpus figures; and
- (d) Statues of religious subjects including statues incorporated in shrines; and
- (e) Other goods designed or produced for use in and of a kind used exclusively in the practice of religion or as equipment for places of worship approved by the Minister of Customs under Part II, Ref. 90 of the Customs Tariff.
