## ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Import Control Act 1988, His Excellency the Governor General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Import Control Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Import Control Regulations 1988\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 199ó.

Omission of certain tariff items from First Schedule—The First Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 3 (1) of the Import Control Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 7) is hereby amended by omitting the Tariff items 6406.10.00 to 6406.91.00 and the Tariff item 6406.99.05.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1990, remove certain Tariff items relating to adults' footwear from import control under the Import Control Act 1988.
