**THE INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS NOTICE 1954,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General hereby gives the following notice.

N O T I C E

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Industrial Districts Notice 1954, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Industrial Districts Notice 1954* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. District boundaries altered—The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from the description of the Wellington Industrial District the words “and the Chatham Islands”:
- (b) By adding to the description of the Canterbury Industrial District the words “and the Chatham Islands”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this notice is to transfer the Chatham Islands from the Wellington Industrial District to the Canterbury Industrial District, for the purposes of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1954.
