PURSUANT to the Health Act 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General hereby gives the following notice.

**NOTICE**

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Infectious Diseases Notice 1955.
  - (2) This notice shall come into force on the fourteenth day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
  2. Streptococcal sore throat (including scarlet fever) is hereby declared to be an infectious disease within the meaning of the Health Act 1920.
