THE INCIDENTAL EXPENSES OF SCHOOLS REGULATIONS 1920, AMENDMENT NO. 2.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Education Act, 1914, and all other powers enabling in that behalf.

Date on which the regulations were made: 31st day of March, 1937. Date of notification in Gazette: 8th day of April, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Incidental Expenses of Schools Regulations, 1920, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made by Order in Council dated the 11th day of October, 1920* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

"(f) Apparatus for the storing and distribution of milk either in bottles or in bulk, and other incidental expenses connected with the supply of milk to school-children."
