**THE INCIDENTAL EXPENSES OF SCHOOLS REGULATIONS
1920, AMENDMENT NO. 2.**

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.
Act pursuant to which the regulations were made : The Education Act,
1914, and all other powers enabling in that behalf.

Date on which the regulations were made : 31st day of March, 1937.

Date of notification in *Gazette* : 8th day of April, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Incidental Expenses of Schools Regulations, 1920, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made by Order in Council dated the 11th day of October, 1920* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraph :—

"(f) Apparatus for the storing and distribution of milk either in bottles or in bulk, and other incidental expenses connected with the supply of milk to school-children."
