**THE INTERMEDIATE EXAMINATION REGULATIONS, 1932,
AMENDMENT NO. 2.**

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.
Act pursuant to which the regulations were made : The Education Act, 1914, and all other powers enabling in that behalf.

Date on which the regulations were made : 18th day of August, 1937.

Date of notification in *Gazette* : 19th day of August, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Intermediate Examination Regulations, 1932, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made by Order in Council dated the 8th day of August, 1932* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").

3. Clause 2 of the principal regulations is revoked, and the following substituted :—

2. (1) Every candidate for the Intermediate Examination must give notice to sit for such examination. Such notice must be on the form provided and must be addressed to the Director of Education and sent so as to be delivered at the office of the Education Department, Wellington, on a date fixed for the receipt of applications which date shall be not later in any year than the Monday immediately following the date fixed by regulations for the time being in force for the commencement of the third term in public post-primary schools.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of the previous subclause, late applications received not later than the fourteenth day after the date fixed for the receipt of applications as aforesaid may be accepted by the Director of Education provided that the application in each case is accompanied by a receipt for a late fee of ten shillings paid at some money-order office of the Post and Telegraph Department of New Zealand.

(3) Applications from pupils of public post-primary schools which are visited by an Inspector of Secondary Schools during the third term for the purpose of determining the award of senior free places by recommendation may be accepted without late fee by the Director of Education after the date fixed for the receipt of applications as provided in subclause (1) hereof.
