**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Industrial Efficiency (Pharmacy) Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 4.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Industrial Efficiency (Pharmacy) Regulations 1938\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 5th day of August, 1949.

4. Regulation 35 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the second proviso, and substituting the following proviso :—

“ Provided, secondly, that if any business has not been carried on prior to the due date of payment of the levy the amount of the levy shall be £1.”
