HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Industrial Efficiency (Pharmacy) Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 4.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Industrial Efficiency (Pharmacy) Regulations 1938* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 5th day of August, 1949.
- 4. Regulation 35 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the second proviso, and substituting the following proviso:—
- "Provided, secondly, that if any business has not been carried on prior to the due date of payment of the levy the amount of the levy shall be £1."
