**THE INDUSTRIAL EFFICIENCY (MOTOR-SPIRITS RETAILERS)  
REGULATIONS 1941, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Industrial Efficiency (Motor-spirits Retailers) Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Industrial Efficiency (Motor-spirits Retailers) Regulations 1941\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, next after Regulation 11 thereof, the following additional regulation :—

“ 11A. Nevertheless, if on the 1st day of April in any year a licensee is lawfully and with the consent of the Bureau not carrying on the industry to which his license relates, then no license fee shall be payable until he is again carrying on the industry.”
