**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to the Imprisonment for Debt Limitation Act 1908, and the District Courts Act 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following rules.

**RULES**

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) These rules may be cited as the Imprisonment for Debt Limitation (District Courts) Rules 1949, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Imprisonment for Debt Limitation (District Courts) Rules 1949\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal rules).

(2) These rules shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Conduct money**—Rule 14(1) of the principal rules is hereby amended by omitting the words “in postal notes”.

**3. Warrant of committal**—Rule 27 (2) of the principal rules is hereby amended by omitting the words “in postal notes”.

These rules amend the Imprisonment for Debt Limitation (District Courts) Rules 1949 by omitting 2 references to postal notes. Postal notes are no longer issued.
