PURSUANT to the Forests Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Indigenous Forest Timber Advisory Committee Regulations 1966, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Indigenous Forest Timber Advisory Committee Regulations 1966* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Membership of Committee—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (b) of subclause (2), and substituting the following paragraph:

"(b) The Director of Marketing of the Forest Service:".

The Director of Marketing of the Forest Service replaces the Director of Forest Economics of the Forest Service as a member of the Indigenous Forest Timber Advisory Committee.
